Yarn Tassels

Mimic the graduation-cap tassel with this easy yarn project that makes a clever napkin ring.

Things to gather:

Ball of yarn, plus several trimmed pieces, about 3 inches long

1. Wrap yarn around your hand to desired fullness, forming a loop.
2. Fold the loop over (in half), then wrap a trimmed piece of yarn around the entire thing, and tie a knot. The top will be rounded, and the ends will be at one end.
3. Cut the long ends to desired length to form the tassel.
